History	<p>The Calgary TELUS Convention Centre (CTCC) opened on November 14, 1974. At a cost of \$8.8 million dollars, it was the first full service convention centre in Canada. A major expansion was completed in May, 2000 adding 68,000 square feet of exhibit and meeting space.</p> <p>Located in downtown Calgary, the CTCC is connected to three 4 star hotels with 1,100 guestrooms in total.</p>
